#### Coverage

The approximate coverage is 2 gallons/100 per sqft or 100 sqft/gallon which results in a dry film thickness of 28 mils. Coverage rate will depend on surface roughness and porosity.

### **Surface Preparation**

Joints, Cracks and Flashing:

Apply a stripe coat of Badger Black over all cracks up to 1/16" width. All cracks over 1/16" width must be caulked with a polyurethane sealant.

All metal flashings must be primed with manufacturer's recommended primer.

#### Mixino

Before application, Badger Black should be thoroughly mixed using a mechanical mixer at slow speed to ensure a homogeneous material. Take care not to allow entrapment of air into the material. Do not mix in an up and down motion.

#### Application

Badger Black may be applied with a brush, squeegee, trowel, roller or airless sprayer. Over smooth surfaces, such as poured-in-place concrete, apply Badger Black evenly in two 30 mil coats. Badger Black can be applied at any thickness.

A manufacturer approved reinforcing fabric may be applied into the wet coating if desired.

#### **Membrane Protection**

As soon as possible after completion of a successful water test or visual inspection and/or repairs, cover membrane with approved protection board or geotextile drainage composite. All horizontal and vertical membrane must be protected.

#### Curing

At 75°F (24°C) and 50% relative humidity. Typical cure time 12-24 hours.

Cure time will vary depending on temperature and humidity. If more than 48 hours pass between coats the surface must be re-primed.

Badger Black is very sensitive to heat and moisture. Higher temperatures and/or high humidity will accelerate the cure time. Use caution in thickness of application. Limit single coat thickness to 30-40 wet mils.

#### Clean up

Equipment should be cleaned with an environmentally safe solvent, as permitted under local regulations, immediately after use.

#### Limitations

Surfaces must be dry, clean and free of foreign matter. Clear coating may turn opaque and cloudy due to moisture penetration, especially in exterior applications. Surface may be slippery when wet. Containers that have been opened must be used as soon as possible. Do not dilute under any circumstance.

#### Storage

Badger Black has a shelf life of one year from date of manufacture in original, factory-sealed containers when stored indoors at a temperature between 60-95°F.
